- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I’m unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition

- My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.

PAYMENT & FEE INFORMATION

Standard Fees

£190 per year/season

- £100 payable by 30th June 2019
- £90 payable by 31st October 2019

This is inclusive of all match and training fees

No refunds will be given to players/parents who leave during the season

Players / parents are responsible for any fines issued to them during a match

This is the first year both training and match fees have been included at the request of parents to make payments easier

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount of £35 per season shall apply

1st Sibling pays full price - £190 per season

2nd sibling pays discounted rate - £155 per season

Total for two siblings in any season - £345

- £200 Payable by 30th June 2019
- £145 payable by 31st October 2019

This is inclusive of all match and training fees

Whilst our fees are very much in line with other local football clubs, Brackley Athletic FC recognises that the cost of football - especially where two or more siblings play – can put a strain on family budgets. Although the full year's fees will need to be paid, we do not want any child to miss out on football due to payment deadlines.
