PAYMENT & FEE INFORMATION

Standard Fees

£190 per year/season

- £100 payable by 30th June 2019
- £90 payable by 31st October 2019

This is inclusive of all match and training fees

No refunds will be given to players/parents who leave during the season

Players / parents are responsible for any fines issued to them during a match

This is the first year both training and match fees have been included at the request of parents to make payments easier

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount of £35 per season shall apply

1st Sibling pays full price - £190 per season

2nd sibling pays discounted rate - £155 per season

Total for two siblings in any season - £345

- £200 Payable by 30th June 2019
- £145 payable by 31st October 2019

This is inclusive of all match and training fees

Whilst our fees are very much in line with other local football clubs, Brackley Athletic FC recognises that the cost of football - especially where two or more siblings play - can put a strain on family budgets.
