Directions and journey time	Turn right on to Pavilions Way. Continue over the mini roundabout (1 st exit). At the next roundabout turn right (2 nd exit) on to the A422. Follow the A422 to Concord Avenue / A4260 in Banbury (8 miles). At Concord roundabout take the 1 st exit on to Concord Avenue / A4260. At the roundabout take the st exit and stay on Concord Avenue / A4260. Turn left on to Swan Close Road. Continue on to Hightown Road. In 0.3miles you have reached the Horton General Hospital. Journey time approx 25 minutes by car
