PAYMENT & FEE INFORMATION

2025/2026 SEASON

Standard Fees

The first payment of £100 is due 31st July ,

Followed by 5 monthly payments of £25 due by the end of each subsequent month.

This is inclusive of all match and training fees

No refunds will be given to players/parents who leave during the season

Players / parents are responsible for paying any fines issued for receiving yellow & red cards during a match

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount of £50 per season shall apply

1st Sibling pays full price - £225 per season

The first payment of £100 is due 31st July, followed by 5 monthly payments of £25 due by the end of each subsequent month.

2nd sibling pays discounted rate - £175 per season

The first payment of £50 is due 31st July, followed by 5 monthly payments of £25 due by the end of each subsequent month.

Total for two siblings in any season - £400

This is inclusive of all match and training fees.

Tigers

The first payment of £100 is due 31st July ,

Followed by 2 monthly payments of £25 due by the end of each subsequent month.

This is inclusive of all match and training fees

No refunds will be given to players/parents who leave during the season

Players / parents are responsible for paying any fines issued for receiving yellow & red cards during a match

BAFC Committee, Manager and Coaches

BAFC Staff Committee, Managers and Primary Coaches are entitled to a 50% discount, this will be payable by a payment in line with the standard fees

Payment

Payment will be requested by invoice following registration
