Turn right onto Whittall St (0.1 mi). Turn left onto Bulls Ln (374 ft). Turn right onto Banbury Ln (0.9 mi). Continue onto Twyford Rd (1.0 mi). Turn right onto Banbury Rd/A4260, continue to follow A4260 (2.1 mi) Turn right onto Hightown Rd. In 0.1miles you have reached the Horton General Hospital. Journey time approx 25 minutes by car
