Directions and journey time	Exit car park & turn right onto Wappenham Rd (0.4 mi). Wappenham Rd turns slightly left and becomes Station Rd (0.9 mi). Turn right onto B4525 (1.5 mi). Continue onto B4525 (5.3 mi). At the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto A422 (1.1 mi). At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit and stay on A422 (0.3 mi). At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Hennef Way/A422 (0.5 mi). At Concord Roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Concord Ave/A4260 (0.4 mi). At the roundabout, take the 1st exit and stay on Concord Ave/A4260, continue to follow A4260 (0.5 mi). Turn left onto Swan Cl Rd (0.1 mi). Continue onto Hightown Rd. In 0.3miles you have reached the Horton General Hospital.  Journey time approx 25 minutes by car
